Played to the F.I.D.E Rules Plus Additions For The Railsport Games

- ❶ **Format** This will be a 5-round Swiss Individual Tournament with an added Team Tournament. It is a five-round tournament, with two standard length rounds on each day plus a quick play round early Saturday morning commencing at 0930. Rounds 2,3,4 and 5 will have the time control of 30 move in 1.25 hours, then a 15-minute blitz finish. Round one will be a quick play game with each player having 30-minutes on the clock.
- ❷ **½ Point Bye** ½ point bye is available to players in round one if requested on the entry form.
- ❸ **Duration** Hours of play are 09:30-18:00 on Saturday and 09:30-16:30 on Sunday (all timings are subject to alteration).
- ❹ **Teams** Players will be allocated into teams of 3 based on their employing company. 1 guest permitted per team.
- ❺ **Officials** The tournament will have an overall controller whose decision will be final.
- ❻ **Scoring** Except in the quick play round, players must record the moves.
- ❼ **Awards** A trophy donated by the Railway Chess Association will be awarded to the winner. It will be held for one year and returned to the RCA upon request. A grading medal will be awarded and subject to the number of entries received, the members of the winning and second placed teams will also receive medals.
